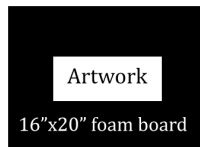
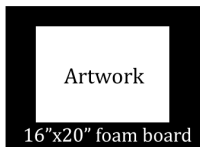

5th Annual Chinese New Year
 Art Competition!



Please use the following guidelines:

1. Artwork should be mounted to a piece of foamcore that measures 16" x 20" in size. Whether the artwork is 8" x 10" or 16 x 20", all artwork must be submitted on the SAME SIZE foamcore board (see examples to the left).
2. The image must relate to the theme of the contest, which is "The Ox Works Hard in 2009." In order to be the mascot for the New Year, each participant should represent a portrait of an ox that includes Chinese symbolism.
3. Each entry should be submitted individually. There is no category for collaborative or group projects.
4. Submit one entry per student. Cut out and attach an entry form to the back of the foamcore. Be sure that it is well-attached and completely filled out.
5. Enter the work in one of these 4 categories:
Category A - Kindergarten thru 2nd grade
Category B - 3rd grade thru 5th grade
Category C - 6th grade thru 8th grade
Category D - 9th grade thru 12th grade

The deadline for entries is Friday, January 23rd, at 5:00PM. All work must be dropped off at the museum in accordance with the above guidelines. The public can vote on the pieces at the museum beginning at noon, Saturday, January 24. Voting ends at 3:00PM, Saturday, January 31. Voting is free and open to anyone.
