6th Annual Chinese New Year City-wide Art Competition



Please use the following guidelines:

1. Artwork should be mounted to a piece of foam core that measures "16 x 20" in size. Whether the art work is 8" x 10" or "16 x 20". All artwork must be submitted on the **SAME SIZE FOAM CORE BOARD** (see samples).
2. The image must relate to the theme of the contest which is, "Keep Your Eye on the Tiger in 2010". Each child should represent a portrait of a tiger that includes Chinese symbolism to be a mascot for the new year.
3. Each artwork should be submitted individually. There is no category for collaborative work or group projects.
4. Submit one entry per child. Please attach one of the entry forms provided to each entry. Be sure that it is completely filled out.

5. Enter the work in one of these four categories:

- Category A K - 2nd grade
- Category B 3rd grade - 5th grade
- Category C 6th grade - 8th grade
- Category D 9th grade - 12th grade

Entries are due by 5:00 pm Saturday, January 30, 2010. All work must be dropped off at the museum in accordance with the above guidelines. Voting will take place at Benjamin L. Hooks Central Library Feb. 2 thru Feb. 26. Winners will be announced at our annual Chinese New Year Family Day on Saturday, February 27, 2010.
